

JOHN BERGERON SCHOLARSHIP

The John Bergeron Summer Research Scholarship provides an undergraduate student (U1-U3) in Anatomy and Cell Biology the opportunity to conduct a 12-week paid summer research project with a professor in the department. At the end of the summer, the student is encouraged to present their results in a lab meeting and consider participating in the Undergraduate Research Conference.

Applications are reviewed and evaluated by a selection committee of professors. Previous recipients of the scholarship are NOT eligible to apply.

OUTCOMES: Learn proper laboratory techniques and troubleshooting skills Develop critical thinking in experimental design and data interpretation Practice communicating research findings effectively Gain insight into the scientific research process
STUDENT STIPEND: \$2,000 from MACSS + \$2,000 minimum contribution from the faculty supervisor = Total of at least \$4,000 for 12 weeks of research.
ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: ☐ Minimum B+ (3.3 cGPA) average ☐ Secure a faculty supervisor from the Anatomy and Cell Biology department (Eligible supervisors)
APPLICATION CHECKLIST: Research Proposal (300 words) – Include the supervisor's name (that has signed off on their contribution to the stipend + the project proposal) Statement of Purpose (1 page) demonstrating interest in cell biology research, including: Previous research or relevant work experience Research interests Academic and/or professional goals Transcript (unofficial or official) Curriculum Vitae (CV)
